#### DRUG TAKEBACK

Drop box will be set up at NBMC in next month or two

Grant from Jordan Cove will fund SHARPS

Will dovetail with Drug Take Back on April 14 at Coos Bay Fire Hall. Free SHARPS containers will be distributed at that event. Les' Sanitation will accept filled containers. Cost is absorbed by Les', NBMC, and CCO. Total of 200 will be distributed. Possibly BAH will house a box soon.

Caryn contacted Renee at HIV alliance re ideas for SHARPS disposal. Douglas County has program for all citizens to dispose of SHARPS .. looking for more info for how funded and run.

Angie Black, NBMC is creating a form for entire pain clinic to standardize info.

Caryn and Rachel will collaborate on work to dispense Naloxone automatically when opiates are prescribed.

ADAPT – Opiate Treatment Program is planned to roll out in June in additional space. Medical Assisted Treatment

Jennifer talked about Gyms for Addiction Treatment – volunteer- run – she wants to get something started in this area. Reached out to Steve Sanden and Deidrie Lindsey. Will try to connect with other personal trainers.

Sequential Intercept Mapping Training .. Feb. 5? .. brings stakeholders together gaps in mental health system.

ADAPT drug education in schools – Marshfield program to offer drug education for students using marijuana or smoking. Work with 9<sup>th</sup> grade health teacher. Cannabis class happening

currently. Opiates may be added soon. Considerable education offered to all schools. Need to coordinate with Rachel presenting with Cal Mitts.

Second year of New DARE starting in NB schools first and fifth grade.

Jennifer gave brief description of Drug Court – based in healing. Highly structured, judicially supervised treatment plan. Team of treatment providers, judge, police, mental health, parole/probation officer. 18 months of guidance, alcohol/drug treatment, etc. Parents must be involved. Judge holds final decision. Brett Pruess probably supportive. Someone from DA office suggested that a community service work group is necessary for participants. Recommended to not use jail as ultimate sanction. LADPC would recommend to County Commissioners.
